




Q2 Age?





Q3 How long have you been attending St. Paul?





Q4 In an average month, how many times do you attend a service?





Q5 Why do you attend church? (Please rank the following 1-7 reasons, 1 as the most important and 7 as the least important.)





Q6 How many years of ministry experience would you like our next pastor to have?








